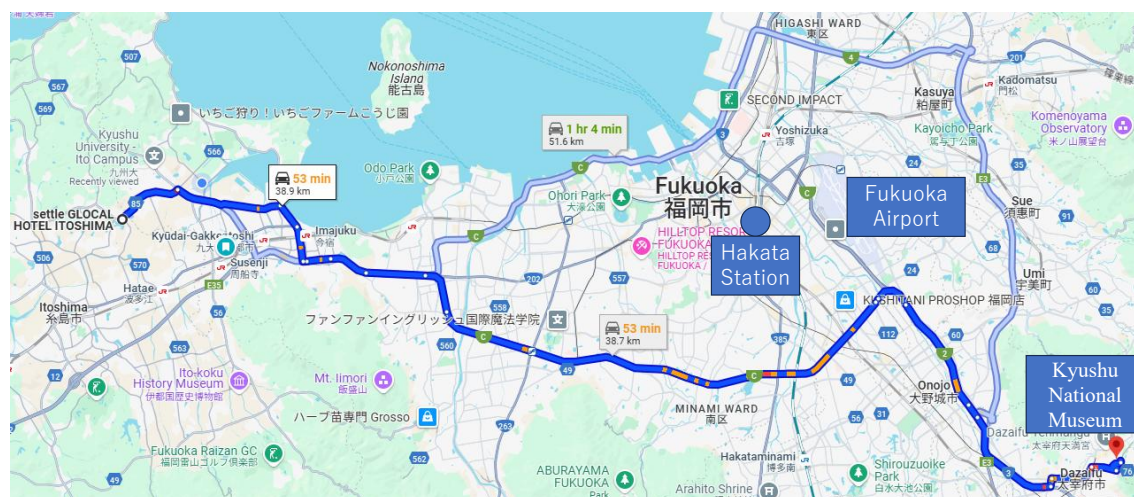

From Fukuoka Airport/Hakata Station to Kyudai-Gakkentoshi Station by Subway

When arriving at Fukuoka Airport/Hakata Station, please refer to the [timetable](#) and take the train bound for Chikuzen-Maebaru Station or Nishi-Karatsu Station.

You can reach Kyudai-Gakkentoshi Station without transferring. (If you take the train bound for Meinohama, you will need to transfer to the Chikuhi Line at Meinohama.)

The direct train from Fukuoka Airport Station (Hakata Station) to Kyudai Gakuen Toshi Station takes approximately 40 minutes (30 minutes).

By Bus (Showa Bus)

You can take the Showa Bus from Kyudai-Gakkentoshi Station to Kyushu University Ito Campus. The bus ride from Kyudai-Gakkentoshi Station takes about 20 minutes and costs 330 yen.
